Italian Prime Minister Matteo Renzi Emphasizes That Stability in Libya Would Benefit His Country Economically

Italian Prime Minister Matteo Renzi recently emphasized that the establishment of stability in Libya would benefit his country economically. Renzi noted that such stability would be advantageous to companies, specifically energy giant ENI, that are involved in the Libyan market. Italy currently manages a military training program in its territory for Libyan soldiers. The program is part of a broader effort by several Western countries to strengthen Libya's security services so they can play a greater role in stabilizing the country. Libyan government officials have praised the program, and Libyan acting Prime Minister Abdullah al-Thini recently met with Italian Ambassador Giuseppe Buccino Grimaldi to discuss its progress.
